## **National 5, Higher and Advanced Higher- Practice and final assessment windows**

St Thomas has devised an SQA assessment schedule to clearly communicate the key assessment pieces which will be used to determine final candidate grades as part of the Alternative Certificate Model. It is anticipated that all St Thomas pupils will be returning to a full-time learning experience after the Easter holidays if permitted by The Scottish Government. With a 2-week quality assurance period in place from Monday 14 June to support subject specialist staff, Curricular Leaders, the Senior Leadership Team and Quality Improvement Education Officers will ensure there is a valid, reliable, practical, equitable, and fair assessment process in place. This means there will be approximately 7.5 weeks from Tuesday 20 April to 11 June for pupils to complete their assessment experience which will support the school in completing SQA estimate grades for all candidates.

### **Supporting your understanding of how Estimates will be produced**

SQA must ensure that its qualifications are credible with users, partner organisations and the wider community, and that they provide nationally and internationally recognised standards of attainment. All assessments for SQA qualifications must be:

- Valid
- Reliable
- Practicable
- Equitable
- Fair

An estimate is a judgement of a final grade and band for a graded National Course across all assessment components. It is based on a holistic review of a candidate's performance as indicated by assessment evidence, gathered at centre level. It is imperative that each estimate is a realistic, evidence-based prediction of a candidate's final attainment in the course assessment.

### **Estimates and fairness for all candidates**

There may be a range of factors that impact on candidates' access to learning. When making judgements on estimates, it is important to bear this in mind, especially in the following cases:

◆ *Candidates who have assessment arrangements or who would have reasonable adjustments in place for a final assessment or exam (for example a reader, or scribe).*

For candidates who have assessment arrangements, or who would have reasonable adjustments, estimates must be based on likely achievement with the reasonable adjustments/assessment arrangements in place. Please note that all our candidates who qualify for assessment arrangements will have these in place for all assessments.

◆ *Where illness or other personal circumstances might have affected performance, meaning that centres should also review candidate performance in alternative assessments of similar demand when making their judgements.*

The centre will review alternative assessments of similar demand should the candidate have affected performance in the practice and final assessments due to illness or other personal circumstances.

◆ *Candidates who experience barriers to learning including those who have caring responsibilities, those who are care experienced, and those who may have further interrupted learning due to illness or disability.*

The centre will review all candidates who experience barriers to learning to ensure that final grades are fair and equitable.

## **Determination of final presentation levels**

Curricular Leaders in conjunction with the Senior Leadership Team will communicate with parents and pupils by Monday 10 May should the pupils' presentation level need to be changed in light of evidence gathered which suggests that the pupil is not on track to pass at the current level they are being presented for.

In order to maximise learning and teaching and ensure the pupil has had every opportunity to achieve at the current presentation level we have purposely delayed the confirmation of presentation levels to early May. The school will present the pupils at the level which will optimise their attainment in each subject area. It is important to note that at this stage pupils not presented at the correct level are at risk of receiving no award for the academic year.

## The revised SQA alternative certification model is based on five key stages:

Stage 1: ongoing until April 2021 – Teachers and lecturers access subject specific guidance, assessment resources and Understanding Standards materials and webinars from SQA.

Stage 2: April to May 2021 – School, college, training provider and local authority quality assurance continues. During May, SQA requests, reviews and provides feedback on assessment evidence from each school, college and training provider.

Stage 3: end May to 25 June 2021 – Schools, colleges, training providers, local authorities and SQA work through final stages of local and national quality assurance and feedback, to reach provisional results that are consistent, equitable and fair.

Stage 4: by 25 June 2021 – Schools, colleges and training providers submit quality assured provisional results to SQA.

Stage 5: Appeals process for 2020–21 – To be advised following consultation. Further details on the [alternative certification model](#), as well as the [key roles and responsibilities](#) across the system, are available on the SQA website.

## Practice and final assessment windows

St Thomas will run practice and final assessments from Tuesday 20 April until 11 June as per the schedule below.

The practice assessments will give candidates the opportunity to experience an assessment environment prior to the final assessments as well as give candidates the opportunity to receive feedback on their performance to support them in their revision and next steps for the final assessment. Practice assessments will only be taken into consideration if the final assessment is lower than predicted and the practice assessment will support a positive increase in the final grade.

Please note that the timings of each assessment in the schedule below do not include extra time for pupils who qualify for this arrangement. Pupils with assessment arrangements will receive this information separately.
