After Year 1

After Year 2

BA (Hons) Theatre & Film (Queen Margaret University)

After Year 2 of the Hospitality and Tourism Academy, the following progression routes are available:

direct entry into HND Hospitality Management (will involve doing 2-credit module placement over summer break)
