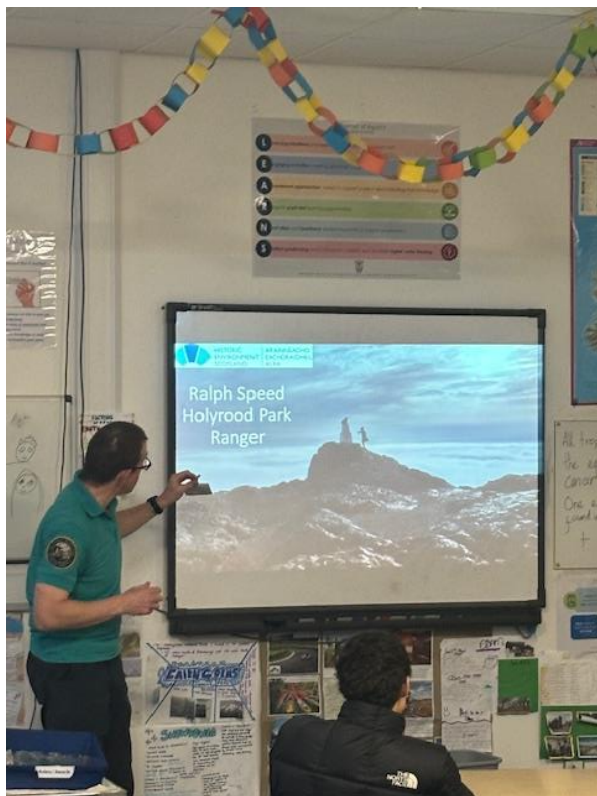


## Natwest Diverski Females in Tech Day- Gogarburn

The pupils heard from numerous speakers on their journey working within the Tech industry before doing a final Lego Building Challenge.

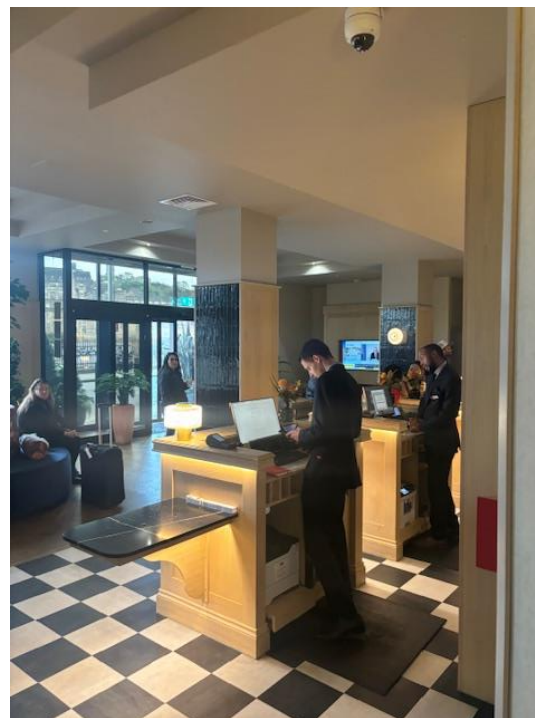




## RAF, Historic Environment Scotland (HES) and AECOM visit to school
