

8. My school helps me to understand and respect other (0 point) people




85% of Pupils strongly agreed or agreed that St Thomas of Aquin's helps them to understand and respect other people.

Mr Murray and Mr Reid have initiated a rolling programme of 2 surveys a year to gather, share, and congratulate pupils on their achievements outside of school. Mr Murray is collating the 1st pupil survey and will update pupils and parents in May.

59% of Pupils strongly agreed or agreed that St Thomas of Aquin's listens to their views. 24% of Pupils did not know and so this will become a theme in the school improvement plan.

49% of Pupils strongly agreed or agreed that St Thomas of Aquin's takes their views into account. 32% of Pupils did not know and so this will become a theme in the school improvement plan.


84% of Pupils strongly agreed or agreed that staff help them understand how they are progressing in their school work.

25. The feedback I receive on my work helps me to (0 point) improve my learning.




82% of Pupils strongly agreed or agreed that the feedback they receive on their work helps them to improve their learning.

81% of Pupils strongly agreed or agreed that they are encouraged by staff to do the best they can.




77% of Pupils strongly agreed or agreed that they are happy with the quality of teaching at St Thomas of Aquin's.
