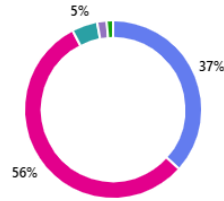


St Thomas of Aquin's 2026 S1-S6 parent survey analysis

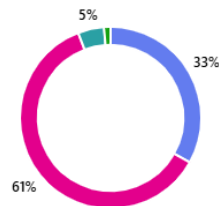

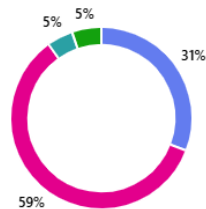

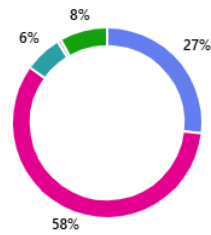

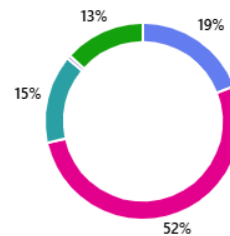

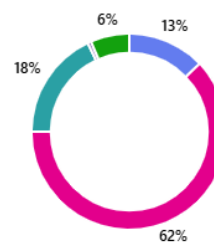

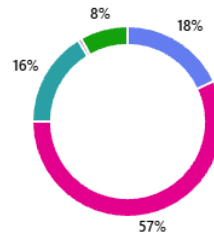

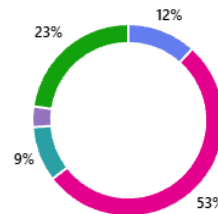

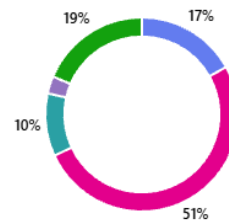

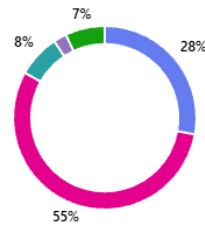

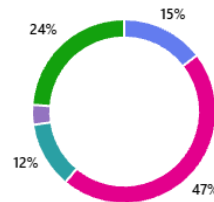

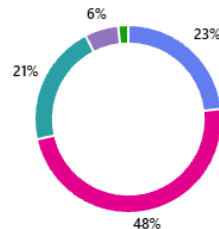

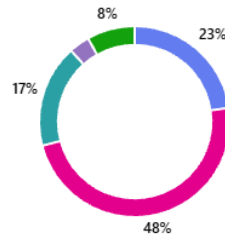

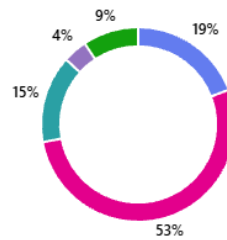

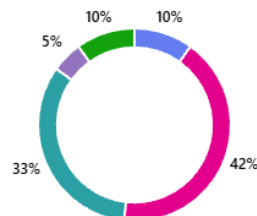

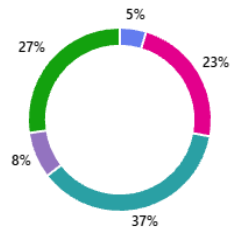

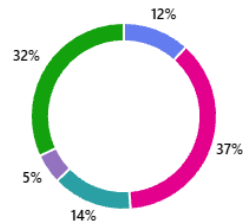

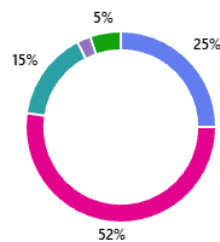

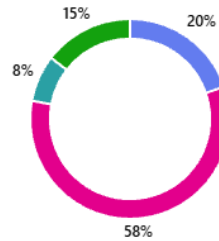

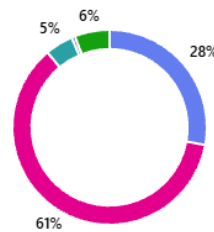

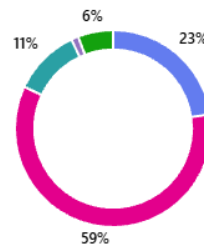

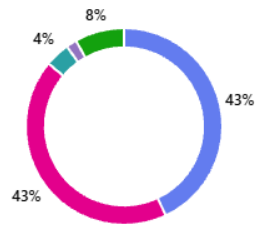

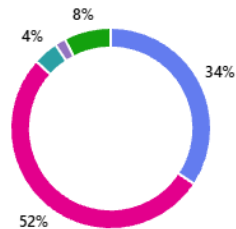

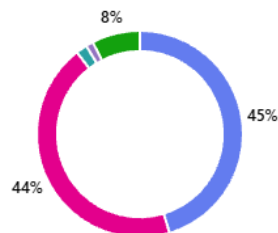

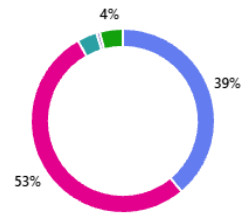
