

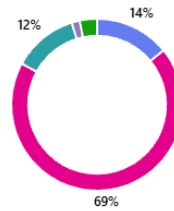
St Thomas of Aquin's 2026 S1-S6 pupil survey analysis

In 2026, **334 pupils out of 813** completed the survey. In 2025, 404 out of 796 pupils complete the survey: In 2024, 465 out of 792 pupils and in 2023, 424 out of 779 pupils completed the survey.

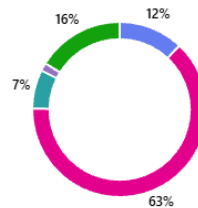

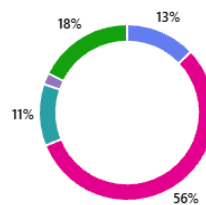

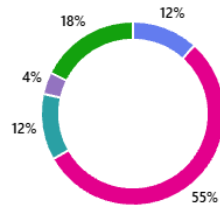

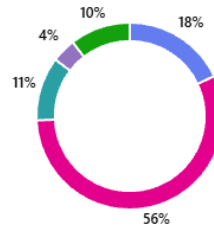

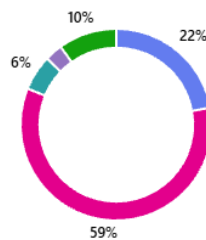

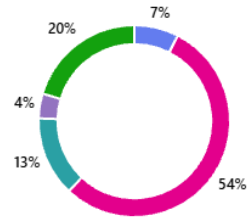

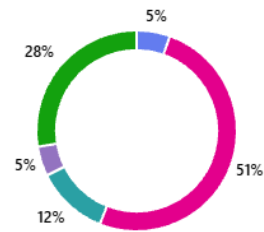

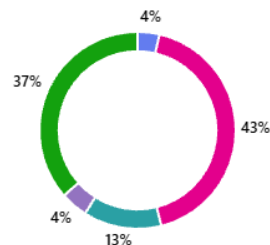

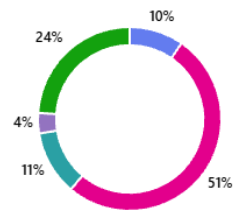

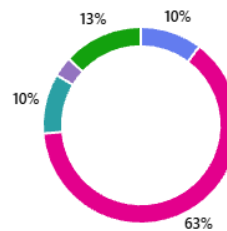

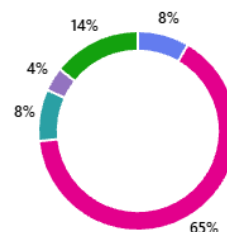

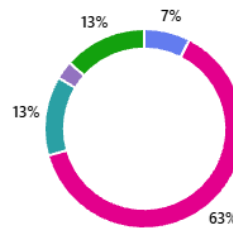

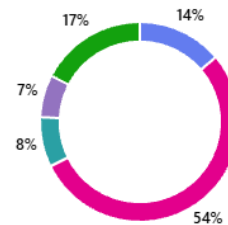

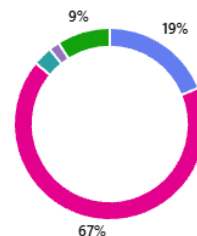

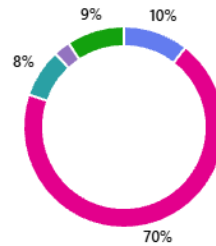

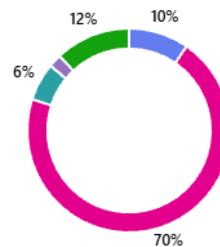

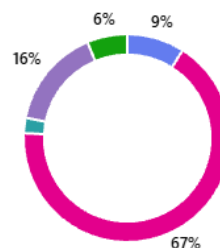

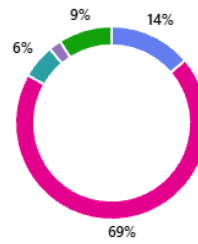

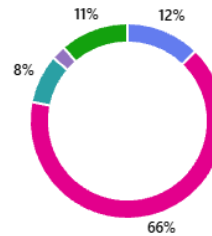

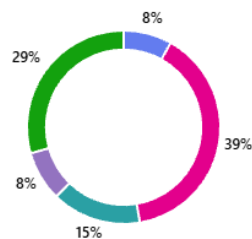
