

WHAT IS THE 50:50 CLUB?

The 50:50 club is a monthly lottery in which 50% of the income goes to the winners and the remainder goes to supporting school activities and equipment.

It costs only £1 per number per month or £12 per number per year and is open to anyone over the age of 16 including current and former pupils, relatives, staff and friends of the school community. The draw for the previous months is made at each parent council meeting and 1st, 2nd and 3rd cash prizes are awarded comprising 25%, 15% and 10% of the income for each month.

Members are free to buy as many numbers as they wish. The more numbers bought, the bigger the prizes and the more funds raised to support the school.

HOW TO JOIN

It's easy! First, download and complete the 50:50 club application form and email it to stthomasofaquinfundraising@gmail.com or hand it in to the school office in an envelope clearly marked '50:50 club'.

Then choose a method of payment from the 3 options below:

1. Internet Banking

A standing order is the easiest method of paying. Simply set up a payment of £1 (or more!) per month to the account details below:

2. Ask your bank to set up a standing order

If you don't have internet banking you can download and complete the 'standing order instruction' form below and hand it in to your bank.

3. Cash or Cheque

If you prefer, you can hand in cash or a cheque made out to 'St Thomas of Aquin's Parent Council Lottery' to the school office along with your completed application form in an envelope clearly marked '50:50' club.
