closes 30th September.

Early September 2020 LNAT testing begins (Law Students at some Universities). If

applying to Oxbridge, pupils are required to sit the LNAT by 15th October 2020 at the latest. Registration for LNAT opened 1st August. See http://www.lnat.ac.uk/registration/ for specific

dates and instructions. Test costs £50.
