Modern Slavery In the UK

It's all over the UK & it's hard to tell if someone is a modern slave since the work they do is normal & not eye catching. Every year the numbers of modern slaves increases & it says it costs for UK about £33M every year there's also around 130,000 slaves in the UK. They can take place as a cannabis farming, sexual exploitation, domestic slavery or forced labour on farms, in construction, shops, bars, nail bars, car washes or manufacturing which could be criminal activities. Children also gets forced to sell drugs & women forced to be in labour.

In 2021 lots of Britain citizens were forced to work with illegal stuff such as selling drugs & others. While doing illegal activity, the people have a fear of being criminalized & would be hard to find the self's to trust police officers. Modern slaves also gets traveled over seas.

This chart is showing us that from 2011-19, there has been 1,873 more people as potential victims. Also every year the numbers increase usually by a couple of hundreds.



How do people become modern slaves

It's by getting themselves into external circumstances that pushes them into taking risky decisions in search of opportunities for families or escaping poverty or insecurity & trying to improve their lives. But some modern slaves don't do illegal activities such as making clothes, being a cleaner, picking up crops, serving food or working in factories. When you become a modern slave or just any slave you cannot escape.
